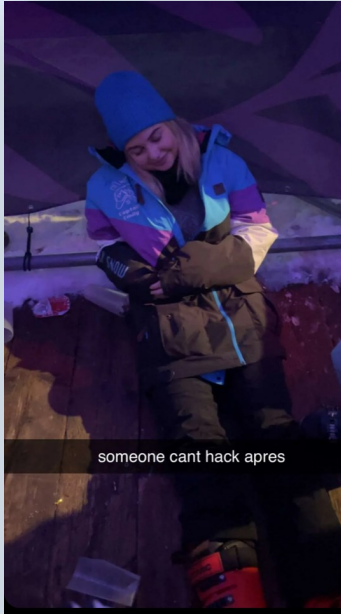


EMILY FOR TOUR SEC
