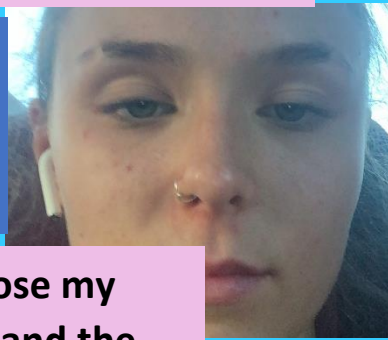
A brief timeline of my experience with WarwickSnow

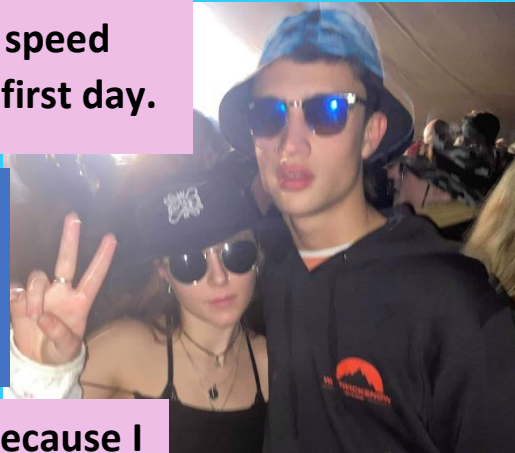
11th Oct 2019 - book onto winter tour (thanks student finance) even though I've never seen skis in person before.

Spend £100 on 4 hours of lessons at Tamland because apparently you need to know how to ski to get to apres.



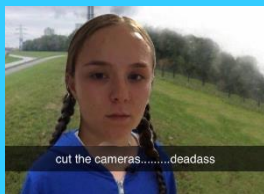

1st Feb - Show off my immense skills as a spectator at Afterjam whilst looking swaggy as fuck in WarwickSnow merch.

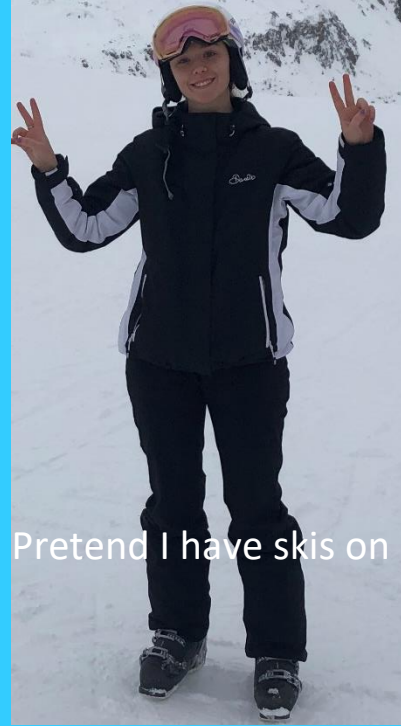


Book onto Easter tour because I love the sesh and hate money.

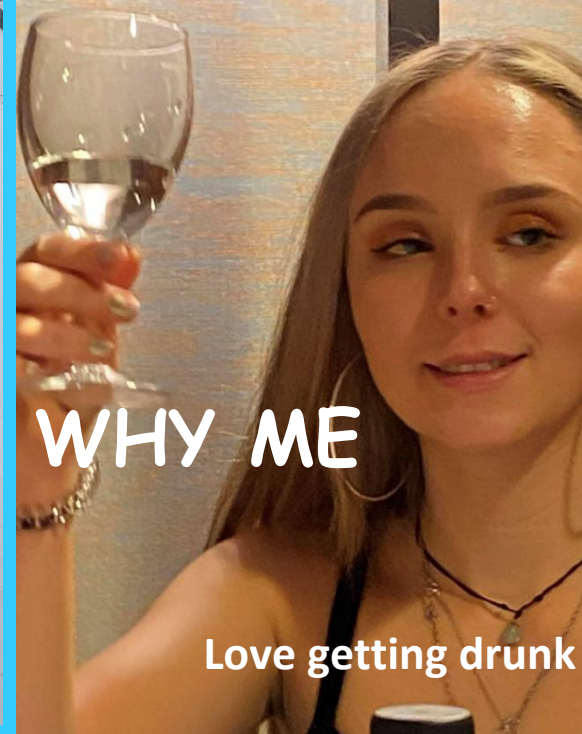
27th of February - Successfully run for social sec, setting me up to become president of WarwickSnow next year.

Love getting drunk

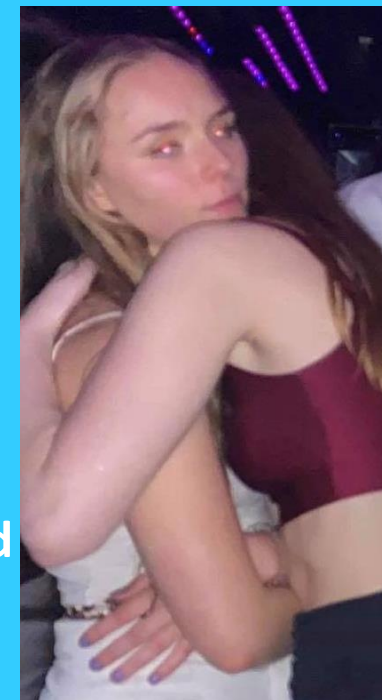
I can show people that snow is open to everyone and encourage more people to join regardless of their background

Bruises from zummie zummie – there's my passion



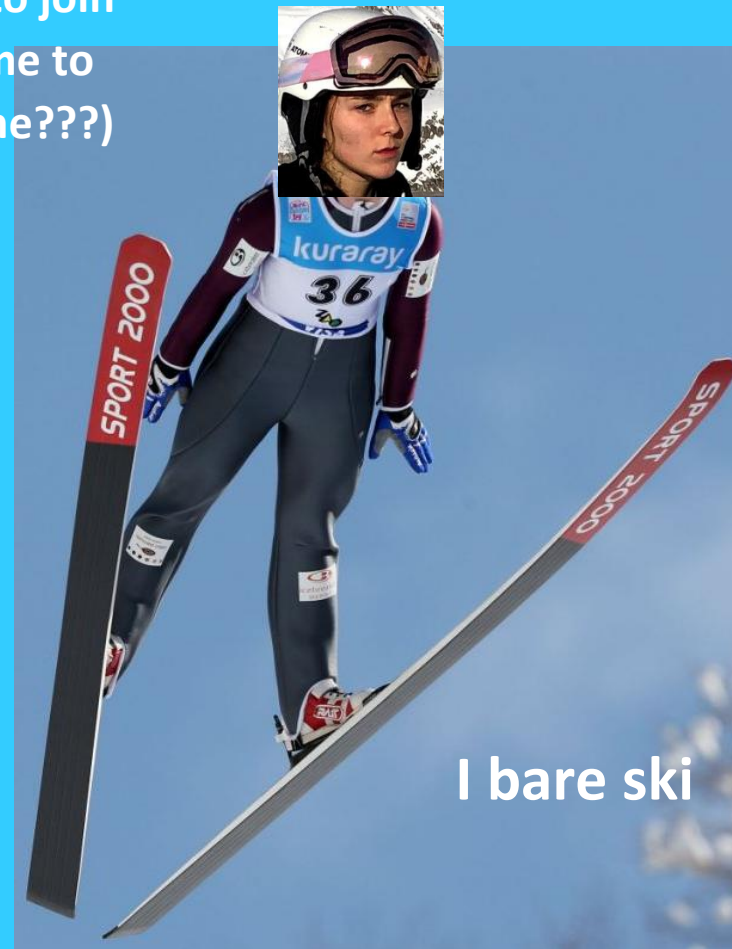
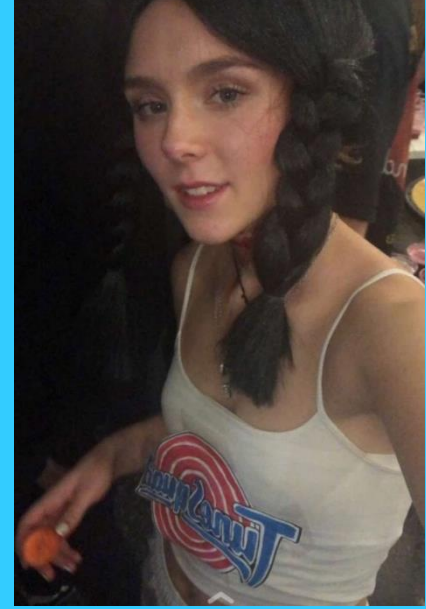
I'm loud as fuck, anyone who's been remotely near me when I'm drunk can testify to this
